- 29 Road Replacement

    decided to discuss increasing the scope of work with Eagle Paving before a decision is made.
  - Cemetery Residence Home Inspection. A comprehensive home inspection was preformed by a licensed home inspector on September 7, 2022. The report was provided to the board for their review.
     Several options to improve and repair the condition of the home were discussed. It was the consensus of the board to contact several contractors to obtain proposals for improvements.
  - Biological Survey James Lyon suggested a biological survey of the undeveloped property to assist in
    the expansion study and provided contact information of a biologist. The board agreed to move
    forward with the survey.
  - RJM Design Group A Proposal was requested for the Expansion Area Study.

#### 1. Personnel

Life Insurance Benefit. The current accidental life insurance policy offered through the California
Cemetery Association is no longer available. Mcgriff Insurance Services, Inc. provided a proposal with two
options for term life insurance. Option 1 for \$25,000.00 and Option 2 for \$50,000.00. After discussion, the
following motion was made:

#### 2. Discussion Items

- AB-351 Reduction of human remains and the disposition of the reduced human remains.
   On September 18, 2022, the Governor approved AB-351. Information regarding the bill was provided to the board. The bill will commence on January 1, 2027 and will follow similar laws to scattering cremated remains.
- Other discussion items included the disruption of office operations due to a computer that was set up by the
  former IT company to function as a server. Soria Ecommerce is in the process of ordering a legitimate
  server and scheduling the installation and integration of the cemetery data management and financial
  software.
